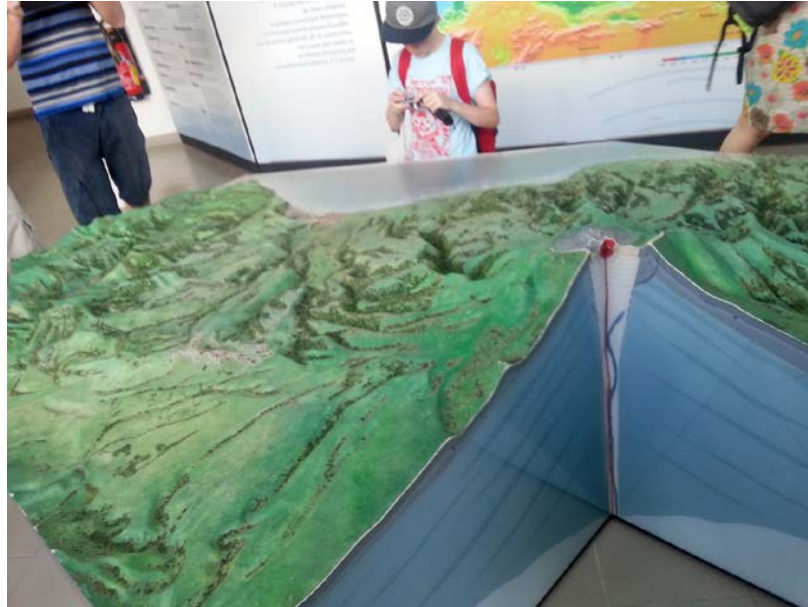
- **Monday 18th :**
