Presentation:

I'm a French student. I'm thirteen. I live in Breuillet in the South of Paris. I study in the ISC – school. Saturday, November 16th

All the seven delegations met at school, Lycée Joseph Gaillard in Fort-de-France. They were coming from Spain, England, Austria, Italy and France. At 10 O'clock we presented our Powerpoint about our school and banana in the Martinique. The others delegations do the same. We ate in the school canteen with our partners and many students of Martinique. I have noticed that the students of Martinique have the possibility to wash their hands just before queueing up for eating.

The afternoon, we were at lessons of Physical Education; Basketball. For me, it was so hot! Around 35 degrees!

Tuesday, November 19th

All the delegations are visiting the CDST (Discovery, Science and Earth). After then, we'll go to the beach and we ate together. We were swimming in the sea; It was funny. We were visiting the Depaz distillery, there are many rum distilleries in the Martinique.

Wednesday, November 20th

We were visiting the banana museum; it was very interesting because we were working about that topic. At noon, we were to Nicolas' home. I was happy because I finished the school.

Thursday, November 21th

We were all the day at school working with all the delegations on our topic: Banana culture. I worked with an English boy in English. It was new for me but it wasn't difficult.

Friday, November 22th

We were kayaking in the mangrove, it was beautiful but the water isn't so clean in the mangrove as in the sea, where the water was so blue. We ate a picnic lunch on the island, we were swimming and we sunbathed. After, we returned at school, and then we took the bus to go at home.
